Lancaster, PA (May, 2007) – On Saturday, June 2, 2007, hundreds of cyclists will gather at Garden Spot High School in New Holland to participate in the First Priority Bank - Lancaster Farmland Trust Pedal to Preserve 2007. This fundraiser to support farmland preservation in the county will offer three leisure rides with routes of 6, 20, and 51 miles, all meandering through the pristine Lancaster County countryside.
